The *GRE*® General Test consists of three sections that provide admissions decision makers with valuable evidence of critical thinking skills: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning and Analytical Writing.

Understanding Quantitative Reasoning

The Quantitative Reasoning assessment measures a candidate's ability to **reason quantitatively**, including the ability to:

- ✓ Understand, interpret and analyze quantitative information
- ✓ Model and solve problems with quantitative methods

- ✓ Apply the basic concepts of:
 - Arithmetic
 - Algebra
 - Geometry
 - Data analysis



Gain a Clearer Picture of an Applicants' Potential

By receiving a distinct Quantitative Reasoning score, you have the flexibility to weight the measurement within your admissions decision-making process based on your program's mission and enrollment goals. Combining this data with other applicant information provides a clearer picture of an individual's potential for graduate program success.
